Every dollar opens a door.
With support and generosity, we're creating positive, meaningful tennis experiences for youth who may not otherwise have access. Your investment doesn't just fund programming—it fuels confidence, connection, and opportunity where it matters most.

- 400** youth in the free Colorado SERVES program for under-resourced communities
- 2,000** students reached through in-school programs
- 1,500** youth participating in center-based instruction at the DTP facility
- 82** scholarship recipients, with **85%** receiving full financial support
- 19** youth instructors developed through DTP's workforce

*2024-2025, we provided **\$125,000** in financial assistance and scholarships. With continued support, we can open the court to even more young players in the years ahead.
